S.D. Constitution Art VI § 24. Right to bear arms. The right of the citizens to bear arms in defense of themselves and the state shall not be denied.

U.S. Constitution 2nd Amendment: "A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed."

2019 Bills Affecting South Dakotan's Constitutional Rights To be Armed

SR6 Oppose regulations that defines a machine gun to include a bump-stock-type device (Pro 2nd = Yea) (Failed)

SB9 Prohibit state agencies from enacting rules to limit firearms rights (Pro 2nd = Yea) (Failed)

SB47 Constitutional Carry (Pro 2nd= Yea) (Passed)

SB50 Allow conceal carry permit carry of a firearm in the Capitol (Pro 2nd = Yea) (Failed)

SB79 Increase the penalties for stealing a firearm (Pro 2nd = Yea) (Failed)

SB115 Allow enhanced concealed carry permit carry of firearms in the Capitol (Pro 2nd = Yea) (Passed)

SB122 Prohibit state colleges from restricting firearm rights (Pro 2nd = Yea) (Failed)

HB1054 Allow the carry of a firearm on a UTV (Pro 2nd = Yea) (Passed)

HB1056 Prohibit local governments from restricting firearm rights (Pro 2nd = Yea) (Passed)

HB1173 Restrict employers from prohibiting firearms in employee's personal vehicle (Pro 2nd = Yea) (Failed)
